#### **Booking Information**

**Acceptance of T & C's** It is understood by East Coast Coaches that all T&C's are accepted by the passenger when a deposit is paid.

**Bookings Cancellations and Refunds** Bookings can be made by completing a booking form and returning it to East Coast Coaches with the required deposit. Reservations can only be held for 7days without deposit. Final Payment is due 30 Days prior to departure. East Coast Coaches retains the right to cancel a tour due to insufficient numbers or unforeseen circumstances. In this instance either a substitute date or full refund will be offered.

**Cancellation Policy** The following fees apply according to notice given— 45 days prior to departure of tour, forfeit of deposit only 30 days or less full forfeit. Where a non-refundable ticket has been purchased this will be in addition to cancellation fee such as airline tickets.

**Tour Costs** Tour Prices are current at time of Printing but subject to change without notice for unforeseen circumstances such as, Higher motel costs, Venues closing and replacing them with more expensive venues. All tour costs include GST. Tour price excludes drinks, telephone calls, mini bars, insurance and personal items.

**General Conditions** Seats cannot be reserved on tours. However, It is East Coast Coaches policy to rotate seats daily to ensure all passengers will enjoy seating.

**Dietary Requirements** Special meal requests must be advised at time of booking. All efforts will be made to accommodate special requirements such as , Vegetarian, Coeliac Meals, Gluten Free & Lactose Intolerant Meals

**Luggage Restrictions** Due to weight restriction imposed on coaches for different roads, passengers are limited to one medium sized suitcase p/p Maximum weight not to exceed 20kgs. One piece of hand luggage will be permitted to be carried onboard the coach.

**Single Supplement & Travelling Alone** A limited number of single rooms are available on each trip. Addition cost occurs for the sole use of a room

## 4 Day Canberra — National Museums, Galleries & Treasures

### Day 1, Tue 1st Apr - Brisbane to Canberra (L,D)

At the Brisbane airport this morning, we board our flight and head to the nation's capital, Canberra! Being met on arrival we start our getaway at **Rodney's Garden Cafe**. Set within the picturesque Pialligo, it's not just relaxing place to stop for lunch, here you'll also have time to explore the beautifully maintained nursery and peruse the wonderful range of homewares at their gift store. After our visit, we'll be joined by a **local expert** who will enlighten us to the stories behind many of the civic buildings at Embassy Row. As our afternoon of sightseeing comes to an end, we soak up panoramic views from the lofty heights of Mt Ainslie! The perfect conclusion to our first day exploring the nation's capital.

### Day 2, Wed 2nd Apr—Botanic Gardens & Memorials (B,D)

After a relaxed morning, we head out to lose ourselves in the natural beauty of the **Australian National Botanic Gardens**. The gardens are noted for growing Australian native plants and cultivating those that are threatened in the wild. You'll have time to meander around the special featured gardens and purchase lunch. Meeting up again, we make our way to the **Australian War Memorial**. Here you will spend time wandering the impressive exhibitions and sombre ceremonial areas that commemorate the sacrifice of those Australians who have served. Later, we are farewelled with the **Last Post Ceremony**. The touching ceremony features the national anthem, piper's lament, an individual story, ode recited by Defence Force personnel and ending with the sounding of the Last Post. A very moving experience.

### Day 3, Thur 3rd Apr —Parliament House & National Treasures (B,L,D)

Head to Capital Hill, the focal point of Canberra where we are introduced to the meeting place of the nation, **Parliament House**. Listening to our guide as they lead us through this political powerhouse, we are taken back by the impressive architecture and daily life of democracy. Following the tour, we have some free time to further explore the galleries and have lunch in the Café. This afternoon we arrive at the **National Gallery of Australia**. Art lovers and novices alike will enjoy meandering through the galleries and admiring the collection. We complete our day at the **National Museum of Australia** - where Australian stories come alive.

Day 3—(Cont.) Listening to our **guide**, we discover that the museum's stunning architecture provides an extraordinary place to uncover the remarkable tales of Australian life, history and culture. *(Breakfast included, Lunch Included, Dinner included)*

### Day 4, Fri 4th Apr —Homeward Bound (B,L)

Departing the hotel this morning, we set out to make the most of our last day here in Canberra. Visiting the **Royal Australian Mint**, we uncover the history and culture of the Australian coin, realizing that it's not just about currency. Afterwards experience farm life with Craig Starr and his amazing dogs at **Gold Creek Station**. Finishing up with lunch you can feel yourself relax after this friendly rural experience. Before our Canberra getaway is complete, we call into **Cockington Green Gardens**. Wandering the path around the charming miniature handcrafted buildings from around the globe, you will come to realise you will literally have the world at your feet! After our exploration we will then head to the Canberra Airport and farewell the Capital as we take our flight back home to Brisbane. *(Breakfast included, Lunch Included)*
