Acceptance of T & C's It is understood by East Coast Coaches that all T&C's are accepted by the passenger when a deposit is paid.

Bookings Cancellations and Refunds Bookings can be made by completing a booking form and returning it to Doyle's Coaches with the required deposit. Reservations can only be held for 7days without deposit. Final Payment is due 30 Days prior to departure. East Coast Coaches retains the right to cancel a tour due to insufficient numbers or unforeseen circumstances. In this instance either a substitute date or full refund will be offered.

Cancellation Policy The following fees apply according to notice given— 30 days prior to departure of tour, forfeit of deposit only 21 days or less full forfeit. Where a non-refundable ticket has been purchased this will be in addition to cancellation fee.

Tour Costs Tour Prices are current at time of Printing but subject to change without notice for unforeseen circumstances such as, Higher motel costs, Venues closing and replacing them with more expensive venues. All tour costs include GST. Tour price excludes drinks, telephone calls, mini bars, insurance and personal items.

4 Days in the Granite Belt

Stanthorpe, nestled in the heart of the Granite Belt is the picture-perfect destination to enjoy a well deserved getaway. Surrounded by unspoilt National Parks you will discover quality handcrafted products, meet four-legged law enforcements in training and witness the grandeur of the towering Bald Rock. .

Day 1 Tuesday 5th April 2022 Home to Stanthorpe (LD)

Welcome aboard! Chatting amongst new friends we begin our getaway to the Granite Belt of Queensland. Our morning stop is at Towri Sheep Cheeses where we are shown a sheep milking demonstration, cheese tasting, and we will have access to the cheese room to learn about the basics of cheese making. By the time we have finished we will know the differences between sheep, cow and goat cheese! Back on the coach we now head to Glengallan Homestead. Uninhabited for more than half its lifetime, it remains frozen in time and is one of the few remaining examples of a 19th century country house in Queensland. Enjoy lunch here, before heading through Warwick, and then stopping at Suttons Juice Factory and Cidery. Located on a working apple orchard, we have a chance to purchase Sutton's unique products before we head to Stanthorpe and check into our motel

Day 2 Wednesday 6th April 2022 The Granite Belt (BLD)

We begin the morning at Aloomba Lavender, where we spend time wandering the gardens lined with tufts of lavender bushes while listening to our specialist guide as they unveil the production and uses of this versatile plant. We head out of town and arrive at Queensland's oldest family owned and operated winery, Ballandean Estate. The Puglisi family have made wine on this estate for over 80 years. sit back and relax as we enjoy a wine tasting and lunch amongst the rustic wine barrels with views over the rolling vineyards. Before leaving Ballandean, we uncover the natural and handmade products of the Washpool Farm Soaperie. Choose from sweet, playful, luxurious or downright practical – there is something in the range to suit all needs and desires. On our way back to Stanthorpe, we make a stop in Glen Aplin at Jamworks. Here we can try a wide range of jams and chutneys all made using only the freshest and best quality ingredients

Day 3 Thursday 7th April 2022 More of the Granite Belt (BLD)

This morning we explore The Truffle Discovery Centre, home to the rare and highly valuable French Black Perigord truffle. Unearth all that is truffle with a tour and gourmet food tastings before meeting some very loyal friends at Lawdogs Australia. Not just for the dog lovers, experience their law enforcing training by witnessing demonstrations of protection, detection and agility in the live "Dog Show With Bite!" After such a thrilling experience we head to the Granite Belt Brewery. Feeling the warmth of the cosy wooden cabin like brewery, we sit down to enjoy lunch before discovering how the craft beer is made. This afternoon we are off to the Granite Belt Christmas Farm. Renowned for bringing the 'Christmas Spirit' alive all year round, we are welcomed by our wonderful host and given a short talk explaining how the farm works and the uniqueness of this magical industry.

Day 4 Friday 8th April 2022 Homeward Bound (B)

We farewell our hosts this morning and travel into Warwick where we collect a local guide for a sightseeing tour of town. We also make a stop at the Warwick Historical Society Museum, a collection of buildings which features furniture and household items representing more than 130 years of family life in the Warwick district. Following lunch we set our sights on home and return to Brisbane.
