**Acceptance of T & C's** It is understood by East Coast Coaches that all T&C's are accepted by the passenger when a deposit is paid.

**Bookings Cancellations and Refunds** Bookings can be made by completing a booking form and returning it to Doyle's Coaches with the required deposit. Reservations can only be held for 7days without deposit. Final Payment is due 30 Days prior to departure. East Coast Coaches retains the right to cancel a tour due to insufficient numbers or unforeseen circumstances. In this instance either a substitute date or full refund will be offered.

**Cancellation Policy** The following fees apply according to notice given— 30 days prior to departure of tour, forfeit of deposit only 21 days or less full forfeit. Where a non-refundable ticket has been purchased this will be in addition to cancellation fee.

**Tour Costs** Tour Prices are current at time of Printing but subject to change without notice for unforeseen circumstances such as, Higher motel costs, Venues closing and replacing them with more expensive venues. All tour costs include GST. Tour price excludes drinks, telephone calls, mini bars, insurance and personal items.

**General Conditions** Seats cannot be reserved on tours. However, It is East Coast Coaches policy to rotate seats daily to ensure all passengers will enjoy seating.

## 3 Day Kingaroy & South Burnett

### Day 1: HOME TO KINGAROY (M/T, L,D)

Welcome to our 3 day tour to *Kingaroy and the South Burnett region*. From our morning pickup we head into the *South Burnett* region with our first stop at the *Yarraman Heritage Centre* for lunch and a guided tour. This once Sisters of Mercy Convent, was built in 1945 and houses a plethora of historical buildings including the *Yarraman Railway Station, original slab hut and farmers cottage, Arthur Brown's butcher shop*. The museum displays the history of timber in the district and the history of the first power house in Yarraman. Mid-afternoon we arrive in *Kingaroy* and call into visit *Kingaroy Kitchen Fine Foods*. Here we can stock up on a selection of chutneys, relishes, marmalades, jams, biscuits, cakes and pies that are created to capture the rich character of Kingaroy. We conclude our day by checking into our Motel and settling into our rooms for our two night stay. *(Lunch at Yarraman Heritage Centre, dinner in motel)*

### Day 2: KINGAROY (M/T,B,D)

Our first visit today is to *The Lavender Farm at Pottique*, located about 10 kilometres out of town. On arrival we can spend some time looking through the large gift shop that is bursting with lavender products including dried lavender, oil, soap, jams, chutney, liqueur along with french country style homewares and antiques. Whilst here we will enjoy morning tea and sample the Lavender Scones and Lavender Cheese. Back in town we can have some free time to look through the local shops and purchase lunch. This afternoon a local guide will join the coach to tell us about the town. Traditionally, Kingaroy has always been the centre of Australia's peanut and navy bean industries. However, since the early 1990s it's also developed into one of the twin hubs of the South Burnett's rapidly-expanding wine industry. Our tour concludes back at the *South Burnett Visitor Information Centre* in Haly Street, opposite the peanut silos. We can watch a short film on the peanut industry and then also visit the *Heritage Museum*. To cap off a pleasant day's touring, we make a stop at Kingaroy's most famous tourist attraction – *the Peanut Van!* It was established in 1969 and now, each year nearly 40 tonnes of peanuts are sold through this unique retail outlet. *(Breakfast and dinner in motel, lunch at own expense)*

### Day 3: KINGAROY TO HOME (B,L)

Farewelling our hosts we depart Kingaroy and head south to *Crows Nest* and arrive at the *Crows Nest Museum and Historical Village*. The museum boasts its very own village! With buildings that have been lovingly restored by volunteers who have paid great attention to every detail to make sure that everything is as close to authentic as possible. See the origins of *Ray White Real Estate*, as this was the location of its humble beginnings. We have a guided tour through the museum and enjoy lunch. This afternoon sit back and relax as we head for home and arrive later in the afternoon. *(Breakfast in motel, lunch at Crows Nest Museum & Heritage Centre)*
