#### **Booking Information**

**Acceptance of T & C's** It is understood by East Coast Coaches that all T&C's are accepted by the passenger when a deposit is paid.

**Bookings Cancellations and Refunds** Bookings can be made by completing a booking form and returning it to East Coast Coaches with the required deposit. Reservations can only be held for 7 days without deposit. Final Payment is due 30 Days prior to departure. East Coast Coaches retains the right to cancel a tour due to insufficient numbers or unforeseen circumstances. In this instance either a substitute date or full refund will be offered.

**Cancellation Policy** The following fees apply according to notice given— 30 days prior to departure of tour, forfeit of deposit only 21 days or less full forfeit. Where a non-refundable ticket has been purchased this will be in addition to cancellation fee.

**Tour Costs** Tour Prices are current at time of Printing but subject to change without notice for unforeseen circumstances such as, Higher motel costs, Venues closing and replacing them with more expensive venues. All tour costs include GST. Tour price excludes drinks, telephone calls, mini bars, insurance and personal items.

**General Conditions** Seats cannot be reserved on tours. However, It is East Coast Coaches policy to rotate seats daily to ensure all passengers will enjoy seating.

**Dietary Requirements** Special meal requests must be advised at time of booking. All efforts will be made to accommodate special requirements such as , Vegetarian, Coeliac Meals, Gluten Free & Lactose Intolerant Meals

**Luggage Restrictions** Due to weight restriction imposed on coaches for different roads, passengers are limited to one medium sized suitcase p/p Maximum weight not to exceed 20kgs. One piece of hand luggage will be permitted to be carried onboard the coach.

**Single Supplement & Travelling Alone** A limited number of single rooms are available on each trip. Addition cost occurs for the sole use of a room

### Day 1: Home to Nambour (LD)

Day 1 Tuesday 17 November 2020

Welcome aboard our exciting Mary Valley tour! First stop is **Caloundra** where we have a boat waiting for us to begin relaxing as soon as possible! **Caloundra Cruises** leaves from the Pelican Waters Tavern jetty for a 90 minute trip through more than 32kms of waterways. Our skipper will keep us entertained with commentary and a bit of fun to boot. Back on dry land we'll enjoy lunch at the **Pelican Waters Tavern**. Feeling content after lovely lunch by the water's edge, we make our way to the re-vamped **Big Pineapple!**\* The attraction has undergone major renovations and in addition to the iconic Big Pineapple structure, visitor centre and train, today the site is home to a popular zoo, featuring over 200 animal species from around the world and boasts one of the largest collections of primates in Queensland. We'll spend the afternoon exploring here before making our way to Nambour and our overnight stay. *(Lunch at the Pelican Waters Tavern, dinner at the motel)*

### Day 3: Nambour to Home (BL)

Day 2: Wednesday 18 November 2020 – Mary Valley and the “Red Rattler”

We have an early start this morning, making our way to **Gympie**, historically known as the “town that saved Queensland” when gold was discovered in the late 1860s. Here we'll be hypnotised by the “clickety clack” while taking the breathtaking scenery aboard the meticulously restored **Mary Valley Rattler**. We enjoy a short tour through the Mary Valley to Amamoor Railway Station nestled in the centre of the Mary Valley. **Amamoor** is an historic town bordered by Amamoor State Forest and a Forest Reserve which is home to more than 120 species of birds. Here the train will turn around on the restored turntable. We can watch this fascinating process or explore the quaint community of Amamoor. We have time for some morning tea (own expense) before continuing our journey to **Kenilworth** where we'll stop for **lunch** at the **Kenilworth Hotel**. Our last stop for the day is the delightful **Kenilworth Dairies** where we'll enjoy a short talk on the property – its history and produce – and a chance to sample their magnificent cheeses, yoghurt and mousse. We'll also have the chance to purchase some of their delicious goodies direct from the maker's factory shop to take home with us. From here we make our way home via the Bruce Highway at the conclusion of our delightful 2 day break! *(Breakfast at the motel / lunch in Kenilworth)*
